DECA Establishment

DECA was established nationally in 1946 with 17 charter states and the first National DECA conference was held in Memphis, TN, April 1947

Geography

- DECA operates in all 50 states plus Puerto Rico, the District of Columbia, Guam, the Virgin Islands, Canada, Mexico, China, Spain, Korea and Germany.
- Texas is located in the Southern Region of National DECA
- Texas DECA is divided into 11 districts



DECA Terminology

- DECA offers a well-rounded "competitive events program" -- not "contests".
- At the local level, DECA is referred to as a "chapter" -- not a "club".
- Persons belonging to a DECA chapter are "members" -- not "DECA students".
- National DECA is made up of state and territorial "associations" -- state associations are made up of local chapters.
- CTSO is an acronym for Career and Technical Student Organization
